Emotional Health & Wellbeing Worker – Somerset Levels & Flood affected areas, fixed term 12 months.

21 hours a week – salary £24,892 (pro rata)

The Somerset Village Agent project is recruiting an Emotional Health and Wellbeing worker, specifically supporting clients who live in flood affected areas in Somerset with distress and trauma resulting from flooding and maintaining their emotional wellbeing through recovery.

Candidates must have a relevant qualification or experience in community mental health work, be able to provide interventions to people with mental health conditions, and be able to manage case work. Knowledge of the impact of rural isolation on emotional wellbeing, as well as knowledge of the flood affected areas would be an advantage. Car Essential.
