Peter Fox

He is an experienced commercial lawyer, and was a partner at Ashfords LLP for 14 years before joining The Legal Director, a law firm providing businesses with part time general counsel support, in 2015. Outside of his legal work, he is one of the founders and trustees of the recently established ROC Taunton Deane, a charitable incorporated organisation set up to run and assist community projects.
